





### **An Extension to Make Products into Batches**

**Bridge Batchcode** is a module to organize products into different batches and set quantity and expiry date for each batch. After an order being placed, the Admin can choose any of the batches to ship the product. The quantity automatically gets deducted from that batch, helping the Admin to manage products in different batches efficiently. The extension also helps the Admin to search the orders placed in each batch and track customers who purchased product from specific batches.

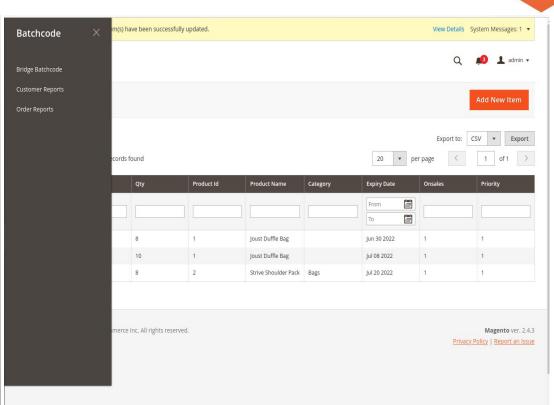

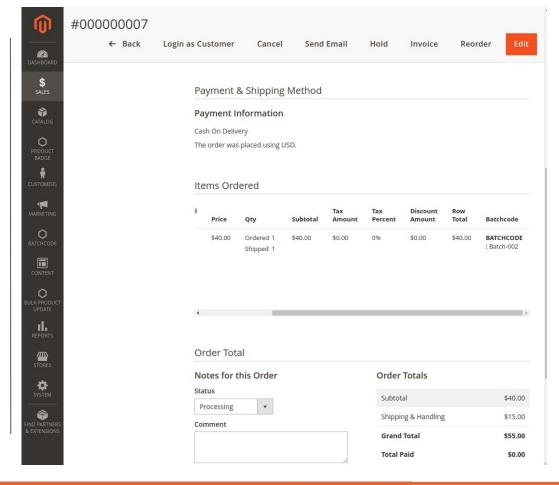

After shipment generation, the selected Batchcode will be listed against each item.











Here, we can search customers who purchased product and shipped from a certain Batchcode.







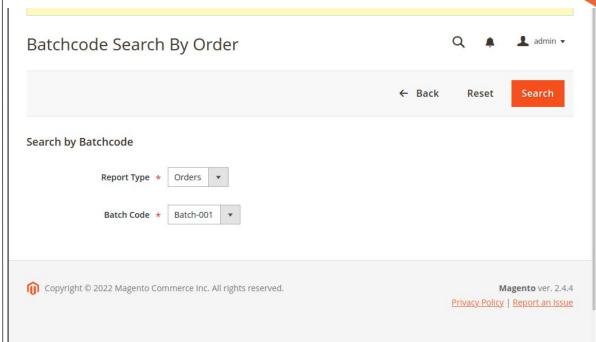
The list of customers who purchased from a certain Batchcode







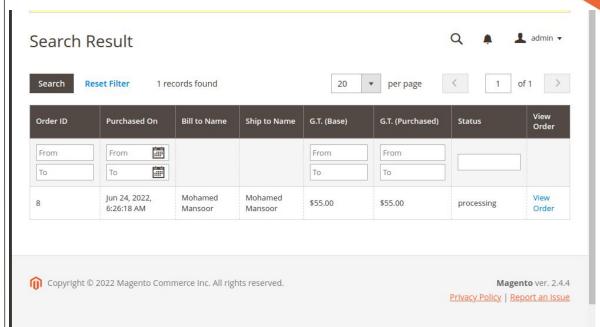
In Search By Order page, we can take list of all orders which are related to the selected Batchcode.








Orders from a specific Batchcode will be listed here.







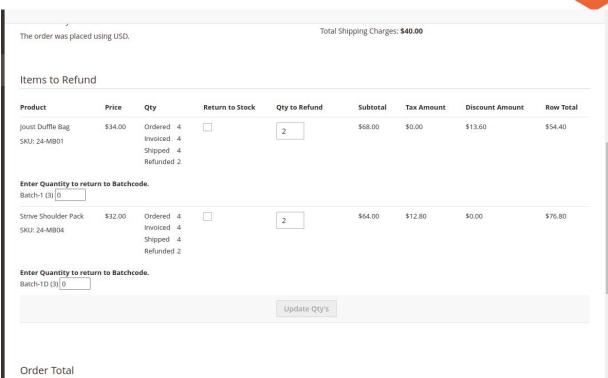
Enable Return Batchcode Quantity.
